PAUSE

Why not find a space and pause for just a few moments, so it's just you and God.

It's really hard to stay still! We don't have to stay completely still to be with God, its just finding time to think about God and pray to him. This can be a walk , when you're drawing or singing some songs like we do at church.

Maybe talk about a way that you like to have quiet time and see how you could use this to pray? Reuben and his mum like to draw and they love music! So when they have time like this together they like to listen to music and draw their prayers.

Why not try drawing your prayers now? God is SO good to us and he loves us to be happy!

Get your favourite pens and pencils and a big piece of paper. In the middle, get someone to help you write Dear God. All together draw or write all the things you can think of that make you and your family happy on one side, things that you want to say thankyou to God for.

Make a Prayer Bottle



Fill an empty bottle $\frac{3}{4}$ full of water and add glitter and any other craft things you might like to, such as shells or craft confetti pieces. Make a cross out of pipe cleaners or something similar. Fill the rest of the bottle with liquid soap and hot glue gun or tape well the lid back on. You could write pray on the bottle too.

Print out the prayer from the pdf, copy it from this video, or write your own and attach it to your bottle.

When I look in this bottle I see lots of beautiful things. Sparkles that remind me that you're the light of the world, shells that remind us of all the amazing things you created in our world and a cross to remind me how much you love me.
